The program **aims to choose up to 16 of the most promising projects**, adhering to the highest standards of innovation and execution.

Selected projects will be showcased to a diverse array of stakeholders within the European technology and innovation ecosystem, gaining significant **international visibility**. They will also have the opportunity to secure **equity investment** from Scientifica Venture Capital and a panel of involved venture capitalists.


Driving European tech leadership
